1. **Blood orders for UBCH** – Platelets are not routinely stocked at UBCH. Consider the UBCH transfusion medicine lab as a "satellite" lab of the VGH lab. There is a minimum basic inventory kept at UBCH – see below. If you need something to be at UBCH for a patient (e.g. antigen negative RBCs or platelets) this is possible, but remember that preop blood orders that are placed in Cerner are not visible to the transfusion medicine lab; it just needs to be communicated ahead of time. If you want something available at UBCH "just in case" you need to fax the TM lab with the patient sticker/details, the UBCH OR date, and what you are ordering (fax 604-875-5284). If you would like it transfused in PCC, also add the order to the preoperative orders.

Routine Inventory Management:

- 1. Check expiry date of red cells daily, reorder if outdating within 7 days (± 3 days)
- 2. Check expiry date of non-red cell products every Monday and reorder if outdating within 3 months.
- 3. Place routine orders on Tuesdays unless inventory falls below min levels.
- 4. Return outdating product to VGH site after receiving the replacement inventory
- 5. Notify VGH of red cell substitution and request update of BAD file.
